Finals – 2008 – Clubs only - 10 best gymnasts from AA are going to the Final 1 per country + 1 best gymnast from organizing club if not qualified.

Finals – 2009 – Hoop only - 10 best gymnasts from AA are going to the Final 1 per country + 1 best gymnast from organizing club if not qualified.

VISA

The request must include the function, full name, gender, date of birth, citizenship and passport number, passport expiry date, the arrival and departure dates of the Delegation Member, as well as the city the visa application support letter must be sent to.

INSURANCE

The Host Federation, the Organizing Committee and the FIG will not be held responsible for any liabilities in case of accidents, illness, repatriation and the like.

The FIG Technical Regulations foresee that all participating Federations are responsible for making their own arrangements to have the necessary valid insurance coverage against illness, accidents and for repatriation for all the members of their Delegation.

The LOC will verify the insurance upon arrival of the delegation members (e.g. cover note or photocopy of the valid policy).

INTERNATIONAL TRANSPORTATION

The invited participating federations must pay the International travel costs of their delegation members.

If delegations will send travel plan later than January 22, 2022, then the local transportation from the airport will not be guaranteed.

LOCAL TRANSPORTATION

Free local transportation:

- from Tallinn International Airport, Tallinn Railway Station or Tallinn Harbour to the hotel and back
- from the hotels to the Competition Venue and vice-versa (shuttle busses)

Will be provided only for the Delegation members who booked their hotel accommodation through the Organizing Committee.

ACCOMMODATION AND MEALS

All delegations must stay in the official hotel of this event, to make it possible for the LOC to provide the necessary health protection measures due to Covid-19 pandemic.

The prices charged for the hotel rooms will not exceed the usual hotel rates. While the Accommodation Form must be returned to the LOC ONLINE – http://rgform.eu/event.php?id_prop=3040 by January 22, 2022, at the very latest, the Hotel rooms will be allocated on a "first come, first serve" basis.
